GENERAL FORECAST DISCUSSION

LIGHT SNOW SHOWERS DIMINISH TO FLURRIES THIS MORNING. TRACE AMOUNTS MAINLY, WITH SMALL CHANCE FOR 0.1" ADDITIONAL ACCUMULATION THIS MORNING. PRECIPITATION WILL INCREASE TO LIGHT SNOW TONIGHT AND CONTINUE INTO EARLY FRIDAY. PRECIPITATION WILL THEN DIMINISH TO DRIZZLE/FLURRIES FOR MUCH OF FRIDAY, BEFORE TURNING BACK TO SNOW LATE FRIDAY NIGHT AND TRAILING INTO THE START OF THE WEEKEND. PRECIPITATION WILL THEN END AS FLURRIES/DRIZZLE SATURDAY. CONDITIONS TURN DRY FOR SUNDAY AND PERSIST THROUGH TUESDAY.
