Forecast Discussion for:

MOSTLY CLOUDY TODAY, CLOUDY TONIGHT AND THURSDAY. LIGHT SNOW DEVELOPS SHORTLY AFTER MIDNIGHT TONIGHT AND CONTINUES INTO EARLY THURSDAY MORNING. SOME LIGHT ACCUMULATIONS ARE LIKELY, 1/4 INCH OR LESS. INTO THURSDAY, THERE WILL BE A CONTINUING CHANCE FOR VERY LIGHT SNOW OR SNOW MIXED WITH RAIN, BUT AFTER MID-MORNING, THAT SHOULD ONLY DAMPEN OR WET PAVEMENTS, DUE TO WARMING AIR AND PAVEMENT TEMPERATURES.
